Medical Assistants are in high demand! According to the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics (2020), employment of medical assistants is projected to grow 23% between 2018 and 2028, much faster than the average for all occupations. As the health services industry expands due to technological advances, and a growing and aging population, doctors will increasingly utilize medical assistants to enable their practice to see more patients. Medical Assistant duties vary from office to office depending on the location, size, specialty and state law.

Clinical and administrative duties may include (but are not limited to):

- Taking medical histories
- Explaining treatment procedures to patients
- Preparing patients for examination
- Arranging for hospital admissions and laboratory services
- Collecting and preparing laboratory specimens
- Performing basic laboratory tests
- Authorizing prescription refills as directed & more!
