The Accounting Associate of Science provides students with a broad based education that will qualify him or her for an entry level position in accounting. Typical entry level positions include: accounts receivable or accounts payable clerks, junior accountants, account clerks, inventory controllers, and full-charge bookkeepers. The program also provides the student with a strong background in computers. The computer related courses include Introduction to Computer Applications, Computerized Accounting, and Spreadsheets. Students may elect to pursue certificate programs in Accounting and Advanced Accounting in lieu of the full degree program.

In addition to specialized accounting and computer courses, the student will take business courses including Intro to Business, Business Law and Principles of Management. The combination of accounting, computer and business related courses provide a well-rounded education.
