The LNA Program is a fast-paced seven-week course that's a starting point in the Nursing field. Many LNAs use the knowledge and experience they have gained working in healthcare to gain entrance into competitive LPN and RN degree programs.

Upon successfully completing the program, students are qualified to sit for the Credentialing License Examinations. The RVCC LNA program has full approval from the New Hampshire Board of Nursing.
