Graduation Rate: (CAPTE Standard 1C1):

CAPTE Standard: Graduation rates are at least 60% averaged over 2 years

RVCC Threshold: Should graduation percentage dip below 70% for any academic year, the program faculty will evaluate and determine if program changes should be made.

Graduation rate is calculated by those students graduating on time plus those students graduating in 150% (3 years) time divided by the number in the original cohort who started the first PTA Program Technical course (AHLT135R) after the add/drop period. This rate excludes those students who leave due to death/disability/military/or health/family/personal issues. This method was adopted by CAPTE in 2019.

Licensure Pass Rate: (CAPTE Standard 1C2):

CAPTE Standard: Ultimate licensure pass rates are at least 85% averaged over two years

RVCC Threshold: Should Ultimate Pass Rate dip below 85% for any one year following all test takers completing testing cycles, the program faculty will evaluate and determine if program changes should be made.

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Employment Rate: (CAPTE Standard 1C3):

CAPTE Standard: Employment rates, as a physical therapist assistant, are at least 90% averaged over two years

RVCC Threshold: Should fewer than 90% of graduates be employed at their desired level (FT, PT, or PRN) within 6 months of passing the National Board Exam, the program faculty will evaluate job openings and current enrollment trends to ensure a balance in graduates and workforce needs.

CAPTE Standard: Program enrollment appropriately reflects available resources, program outcomes and workforce needs

RVCC Threshold: The program allows matriculation of no greater than 24 students per cohort. A cohort is defined as those students beginning AHLT 135R in the first fall semester and on track to participate in clinical education PTAC 190R the following summer.
